## **Best Practice - 2 Social outreach and community engagement**

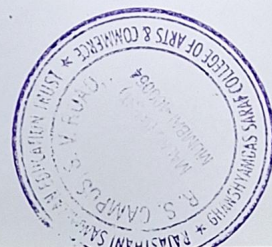

### DLLE: Cleanliness drive at hospital

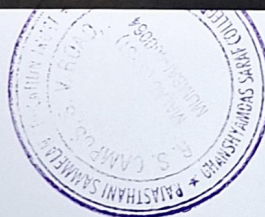
To create awareness and understanding the importance of waste segregation at source, to increased awareness and educational value with regards to cleanliness of public spaces.





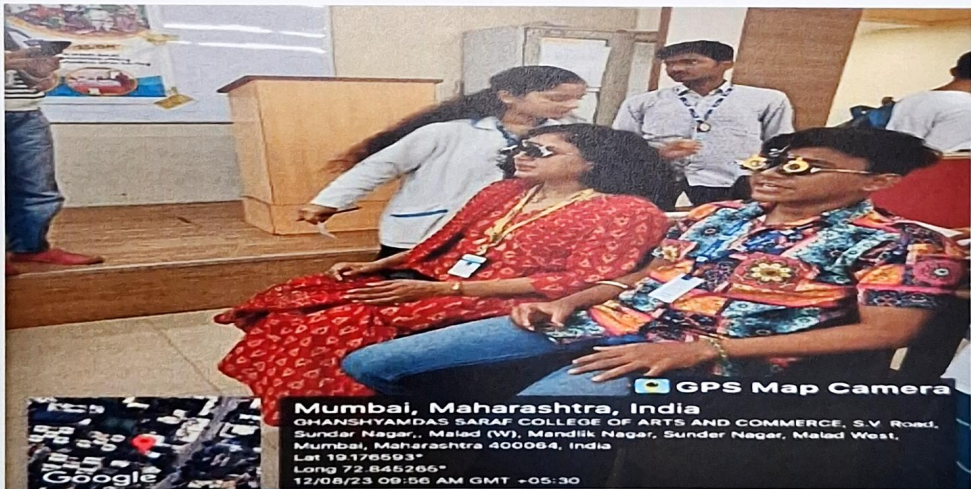
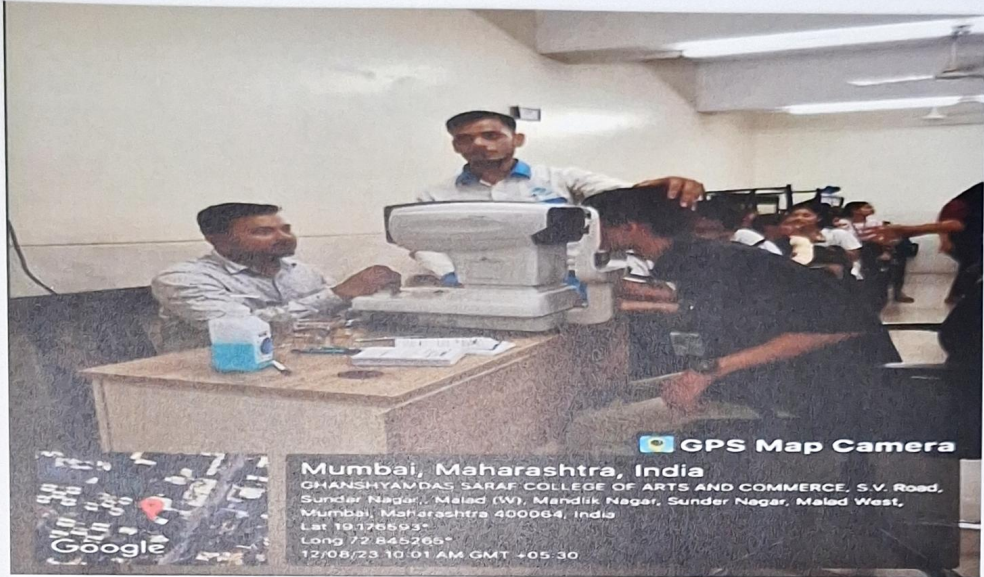
## DLLE: Guest Lecture on Heart Day by Cardiologist

For celebration of heart week, this helps in educating people about risk factors, prevention strategies, early detection ultimately contributing to better heart health and reducing the burden of heart related illness.



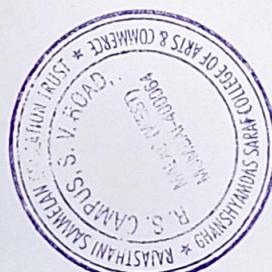
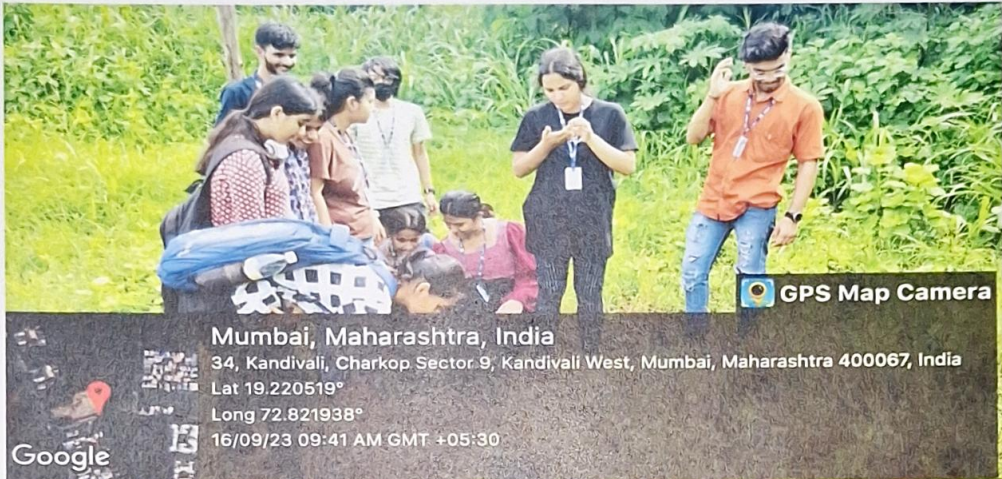
## DLLE: Eye Checkup Camp

Camp conducted to spread awareness about eye related ailments, to provide free eye checkup by trained optometrists free of cost.



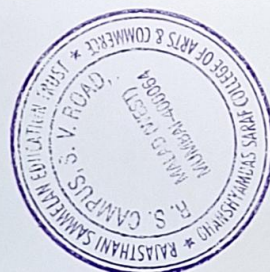

Drive conducted to help nature and mother earth to get its natural beauty and components back. To help students understand the value of plants and trees and inspire students to provide these services to society.



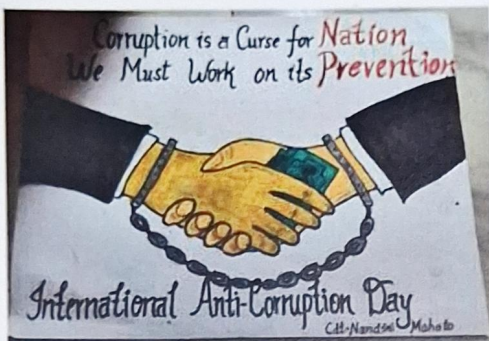
